

## A MESSAGE FROM... | 03

## A Message from MONSIGNOR ZURAW

We read in Sacred Scripture:

No one patches an old cloth with a piece of new unshrunken cloth, for its fullness pulls away from the cloth and the tear gets worse.

People do not put new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the skins burst, the wine spills out, and the skins are ruined. Rather, they pour new wine into fresh wineskins, and both are preserved. Mark 2:18-22

This sacred scripture reading will be proclaimed on Monday, January 20 and is an invitation for us to consider our new venture as St. Catherine of Siena Parish. Jesus is teaching us why we should shed off our old ungodly ways and habits in order to accommodate the new ways He teaches us through His Holy Word.

We are in a time of wineskin change. Let us celebrate that instead of wringing our hands in frustration for the good old days. Let us thank God for the old wineskins, each of our traditions, let us celebrate the new wineskins of a future full of hope and spiritual nourishment. We can do both, we do not have to choose. This is a great time to remember those who founded our parishes. This is also the time to create a parish for our future generations. We cannot afford to keep squabbling about what was. We must stop that at once. God needs all hands-on deck. We cannot continue operating as if we are a private club with members, dues, and privileges. Jesus never acted like that. Our community needs us unified; the Church needs us unified. We need to be unified as the Body of Christ.

I know that it is hard to move forward when we are fearful of the unknown. Anxiety takes the fun out of our lives. We do not have to be afraid. God's love casts out fear. God is with us. God orchestrates systems of change. Change happens all the time, so that we can experience God at work in our lives and in our world. God knows



how hard it is for us to let go and change. But do we realize that we are at the beginning of a new and great adventure.

If we say yes to God's direction, we can rely on God already having said yes to us. By working together, all of us moving in the same direction, allowing God to lead us. When that happens, others will know that Jesus lives in our new community. If our God is the directional force we will encounter the real tradition, the tradition behind the traditions, because our community will experience it in us.

This weekend we begin one weekly bulletin for our parish. It may take a little bit of tweaking at the beginning, but I ask that we be patient as we work to create something new.

Also, over the last few months, the Parish Council has been working on

a new parish prayer. Beginning the weekend of February 2 & 3 a new parish prayer will be recited as the last petition in the Universal Prayers of the Church. Copies will be made and inserted in our music books. This prayer of intercession reads:

Almighty God, through the intercession of St. Catherine of Siena, grant us the courage to speak your truth with love and conviction. Help us to be a fearless advocate for justice and righteousness, guided by the Holy Spirit. Teach us to be compassionate as we strive to be a faithful witness to the gospel message. In Jesus' name we pray... Lord hear our prayer.



## Blessing of Throats WHO IS ST. BLAISE AND WHY

WHO IS ST. BLAISE AND WHY DO WE BLESS THROATS IN HIS HONOR?

You may be familiar with the annual "blessing of throats" that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions, and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command,



the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

St. Catherine of Siena Parish will be blessing throats the weekend of February 1 & 2, after all the Masses in honor of St. Blaise.
