A Message from

DN. MIKE KOCJANCIC

The Art of Marriage, a Sacrament of Service

Kathy and I were with a group and one of the participants mentioned how she loved the banter between us. She asked Kathy how many years we have been happily married, to which Kathy replied, "Fifty-one." I added, "Yes, but we've been officially married fifty-two, so obviously..."

The United States Catholic Catechism for Church defines marriage as an act of worship that is an expression of faith and a sign of Church's unity. God is madly in love with us and has a dream for us. Sacraments not only show us what God is like and what God dreams for us, sacraments also make it happen.

In the Old Testament world, marriage was primarily for preservation of the husband's clan. Then Jesus came along and things changed, Marriage became a sacrament and the love and oneness between man and woman is to be the same as the love and oneness between Christ and his Church. Christ would do anything for us, and we are to do the same for one another.

Our OCIA group has learned that one of the many definitions of sacrament is an outpouring of God's grace that calls for a response on our part. A sacrament is not just for show but involves making a change in us (How many couples spend most of their planning time on the reception and honeymoon and not discuss faith issues both in their lives now and when they are married?) Any sacrament, especially marriage, will impact our identity as an individual and as a couple.

So how is the love in marriage to be expressed? The same way as the love God expresses for us. God's love is chosen to be received by us and is not forced upon us; it limits our choices but without diminishing fulfillment in our lives. It is to be total with no conditions or limits, everywhere and every time. It is to be faithful, exclusive of all others just as we are to have no other gods before



our God. And, it is to be fruitful, sacrificing the old which leads to a new life of resurrection and salvation.

Wilferd Arlan Peterson wrote a beautiful reflection on The Art of Marriage:

Happiness in marriage is not something that just happens.

A good marriage must be created. In the art of marriage, the little things are the big things...

It is never too old to hold hands.

It is remembering to say "I love you" at least once a day.

It is never going to sleep angry.

It is not taking the other for granted; the courtship should not end with the honeymoon but continue through all the years.

It is having a mutual sense of values and common objectives.

It is standing together to face the world.

It is forming a circle of love that gathers in the whole family.

It is doing things for each other, not in the attitude of duty or sacrifice, but in the spirit of joy.

It is speaking words of appreciation

and demonstrating gratitude in thoughtful ways.

It is not looking for perfection in each other.

It is cultivating flexibility, patience, understanding, and a sense of humor.

It is having the capacity to forgive and forget.

It is giving each other an atmosphere in which each can grow.

It is finding room for the things of the spirit.

It is a common search for the good and the beautiful.

It is establishing a relationship in which independence is equal, dependence is mutual, and the obligation is reciprocal.

It is not only marrying the right partner, it is being the right partner.

It is discovering what marriage can be, at its best.
