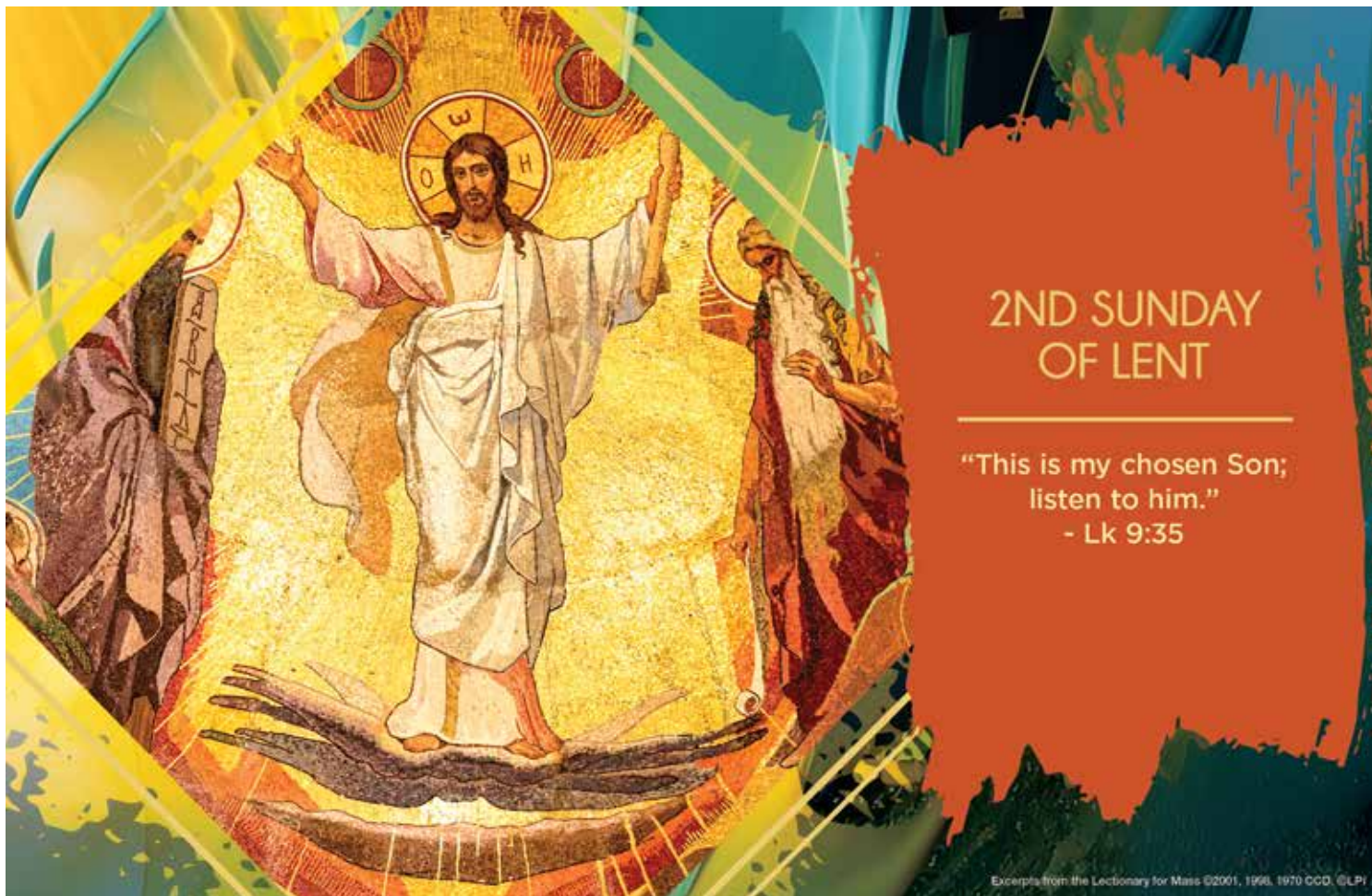

A Message from

DN. BOB REDIG

Alleluia! Whoops, am I allowed to say that during Lent? For the record, and just to be safe, I just typed "that word." I didn't actually say it. Besides, it wouldn't be as bad as disobeying the warning on a mattress tag that states "Do Not Remove Under Penalty of Law." Not me. I've been intimidated by those tags for over 76 years.

In any event, as long as I can remember sleeping on any mattress, the season of Lent has been a constant companion along my faith journey. One of my earliest memories of Lent growing up was praying with my family. As children, each night after supper during Lent, the five of us siblings, along with mom and dad, would gather together in the living room and pray the rosary as a family. Each of us would kneel as we prayed, supported by a chair or the couch (it was called the davenport then).

As we became old enough to do so, each child had the duty of announcing a particular mystery, or leading the first half of each Hail Mary and Our Father. While we were praying, any number of our friends were often outside on the front porch, waiting for any one of us to come outside to play. Knowing that none of us were going to come out until the rosary was finished, a friend or two would sometimes come inside and pray with us.

Another memory from my childhood (maybe it was during Lent, I don't remember) was being in our living room one evening when there was a knock on the front door. Opening the door revealed a shabbily dressed man holding



open a burlap sack as if he were trick-or-treating. Dad immediately went into the kitchen and retrieved a can of soup, which he dropped into the man's sack. Closing the door, dad announced to all of us that we should never fail to share our food with someone who needed it. A great lesson that I remember from many years ago.

What are some of your own Lenten memories? As we all journey together through this holy season, it's important to remember the memories and spiritual practices of the past. And it's just as important to share them with others and teach them to our children. The long-ago childhood memories that I share in this short reflection encompass the disciplines of Lent:

Announcing the mysteries of our faith – Prayer

Replacing play time with prayer time – Fasting

A simple can of soup for the hungry – Almsgiving

A new Lenten discipline for

me this time around is to not watch television. Not that I watch an inordinate amount of TV – usually the news, along with only a handful of other shows. But I will set aside the time away from the TV and use it for more prayer and spiritual reading. However, since I won't be watching the news, if your path happens to cross with mine during Lent, and I ask you "What's new," I might require a detailed answer.

This weekend, though, the light that would normally shine forth from my television, is more than abundantly replaced by the radiance of the Transfiguration. What a great way to celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent! The light of the glorified Christ shatters the darkness in our world! We are all illuminated through Christ's glory! We all have a share in His glory! Praise the Lord! By the way, "Praise the Lord" in a transliteral sense, means you guessed it – Alleluia! There, I've said (typed) it again.

DID YOU KNOW?

Pope Urban called upon St. Catherine to travel to Rome and support his cause. Initially, she was reluctant, fearing the label of a meddler, but once the official orders arrived, she made her way to Rome. Several Italian republics, such as Siena and Florence, were falling behind in their financial and military assistance to Pope Urban, which strained their relationship further. In response, St. Catherine attempted to help by writing letters advocating for Pope Urban.
