A Message from MSGR. ZURAW

Most of us are familiar with the term "freeloader." It refers to a person who takes and takes but makes little or no effort to put anything back. If you go out to lunch with a freeloader more often than not, he or she will forget to bring any money. You and I do not enjoy the company of a freeloader, and most of all we do not want to be one.

In today's Gospel, Jesus told a story about this pattern of life. But the freeloader in this instance is not a person. It is a fig tree. The tree draws strength and sustenance from the soil. But it never gives anything back. It never produces any figs. Jesus concern in today's reading was about people who take without giving back.

The fig tree in the story did not produce rotten fruit. That would have been ample reason to cut it down. But Jesus condemned the tree for producing nothing. We recall that he once told a story about a man who was traveling from Jerusalem down to Jericho. Along the way that man was assaulted by thieves. They beat him, robbed him and left him beside the road to die. This story is known as the story of the Good Samaritan. Remember why he told it. His purpose was not to inveigh against thieves and robbers. They were in the story, and certainly Jesus opposed their actions. But they were not his primary target. In the story, Jesus took aim at the priest and Levite who saw the wounded

man but passed him by and did nothing.

Few things are more wrong than seeing a need and making no attempt to meet it. In the eyes of Jesus, it is wrong not to care. It is wrong not to work. It is wrong not to give. It is wrong not to help. That is why the landowner ordered the fig tree cut down. It was non-productive. It did nothing.

Consider that doing nothing is wasteful. The owner in today's reading said, "three years I have come seeking fruit on this tree and found none. Cut it down. Why should it use up the ground." A death sentence was imposed on the tree for the crime of uselessness. It is exceedingly wasteful to do nothing. That is one of the basic laws of life. We either use what we have, or we lose it.

It is true physically. Suppose that you were to bind your right arm to your body. You wrap it so tightly that you cannot use it or even lift it. And suppose you leave it there for six weeks. For a month and a half, your arm endures an imposed period of idleness. Then you unwrap the arm and set it free. At that point you would probably be unable to lift your arm. If the use is not lost, it will certainly be impaired. Our muscles are not made to be dormant. They are made for movement. And if we do not use them, we will seriously damage our ability to use them.


This also applies domestically. The husband or wife takes

up the habit of verbal abuse. Things are said that are terrible. They no longer say please or thank you or I love you. They drop the common courtesies that keep married life civilized. They no longer celebrate anniversaries or birthdays. And little by little, through simply doing nothing they destroy their marriage.

We can see the same thing in our interaction with our young people. All we need to do is just leave them alone. Pay no attention to them. Little by little doing nothing reflects and attitude that we don't care.

When it come to our faith life and parish involvement, doing nothing reflects and attitude that if I don't get my own way, then God is not listening to me, or I am just going to stop attending. Our patron saint, Catherine of Siena reminds us that if we just sit on our hands and do nothing, we are impeding God's work in and through us. We are the face of God in today's world.

Doing nothing is one of the most wasteful luxuries that anyone can indulge. Life is not a free ride. We have an obligation to put back into life as much as we take out. Let us all do something, lest we slip into the subtle sin of doing nothing.

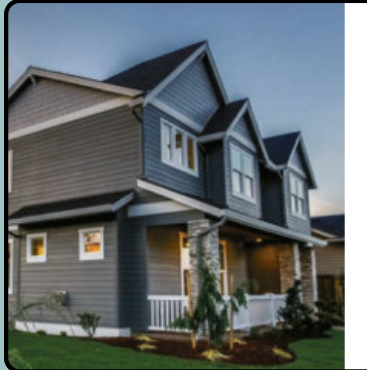

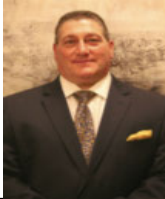
