2024 Easter Message from Msgr. Zuraw (and Sister Mary Alyce)

Easter Sunday is the greatest day in the Church's calendar. Jesus has over-come death, not only for himself, but for all of us. The joy of Easter fills the earth, the joy that death has been conquered. Today we open our hearts to receive this great joy. Today we move from darkness to light. Today we continue our relationship with Jesus Christ and his church to celebrate and live what we believe.

The Gospel reading tells us about the discovery of the empty tomb. The empty tomb is the first step towards establishing the truth that Jesus had escaped the bonds of death, and it prepares the disciples to encounter the risen Lord. Easter offers us the opportunity to reflect on what it means to be baptized members of Christ's Body. What it means to be Church.

Several weeks ago, it was announced that Saint Charles and Saint Luke would be merged by the end of 2024. The majority of us live out our faith in a specific place, at a specific time and with specific people. The parish is the way of encountering Jesus with people we have come to know and love. Parish is personal. When members of a parish hear that they are going to merge, questions immediately flood their minds. Will one parish be preferred over another? Does this mean that our parish will close? What about our parish traditions and customs? What will I have to give up?

Grief, sadness and anger can set in quickly. It manifests itself in various ways. How can this be happening? Why is this happening to us? Why even bother? Aren't you just going to close our parish in a few years anyway? At times, people try to bargain. If this happens, we will refuse to give. Sometimes people will leave for another parish, reduce their contributions or simply leave the Catholic Church all together. Here are a few things we need to learn about how to navigate transitions in life.

The first piece of advice is to pray. We imitate Jesus, who took time for prayer and reflection. Prayerful discernment through the Holy Spirit is essential. Remember, "Nothing is impossible for God."

Second, engage the people involved. The more engaged people are the better we can manage change positively. During the months of April and May we will have listening sessions after each of the Masses regarding the merger. Since change involves risk and often means embarking into unknown territory, it is imperative that communication is transparent and characterized by compassionate listening.

And third, using Jesus as our model, compassion must flow throughout the process. People can't be rushed through change. Communities that do not allow for grief in dealing with a change of this magnitude can hold on to their anger and division for generations. A major change like this can wound a parish community. But wounds can heal if they are well cared for. In time, scar tissue can grow, leaving the site of the wound even stronger than before.

The Church is no stranger to controversy. Unfortunately, it is also no stranger to corruption, division and stifling bureaucracy. Above all, it is also no stranger to renewal and revival. This pilgrim Church of ours has been around for over two thousand years and has survived. We say, the Spirit of Jesus is alive in our Church. And remember we must prove ourselves right.

On this Easter Sunday, Jesus appeared to the frightened and disheartened disciples and said, "Peace be with you." Then he showed them his wounded hands and side and they were filled with joy. Grant that we who have heard the message of Easter may enjoy peace and unity during this time of change.
