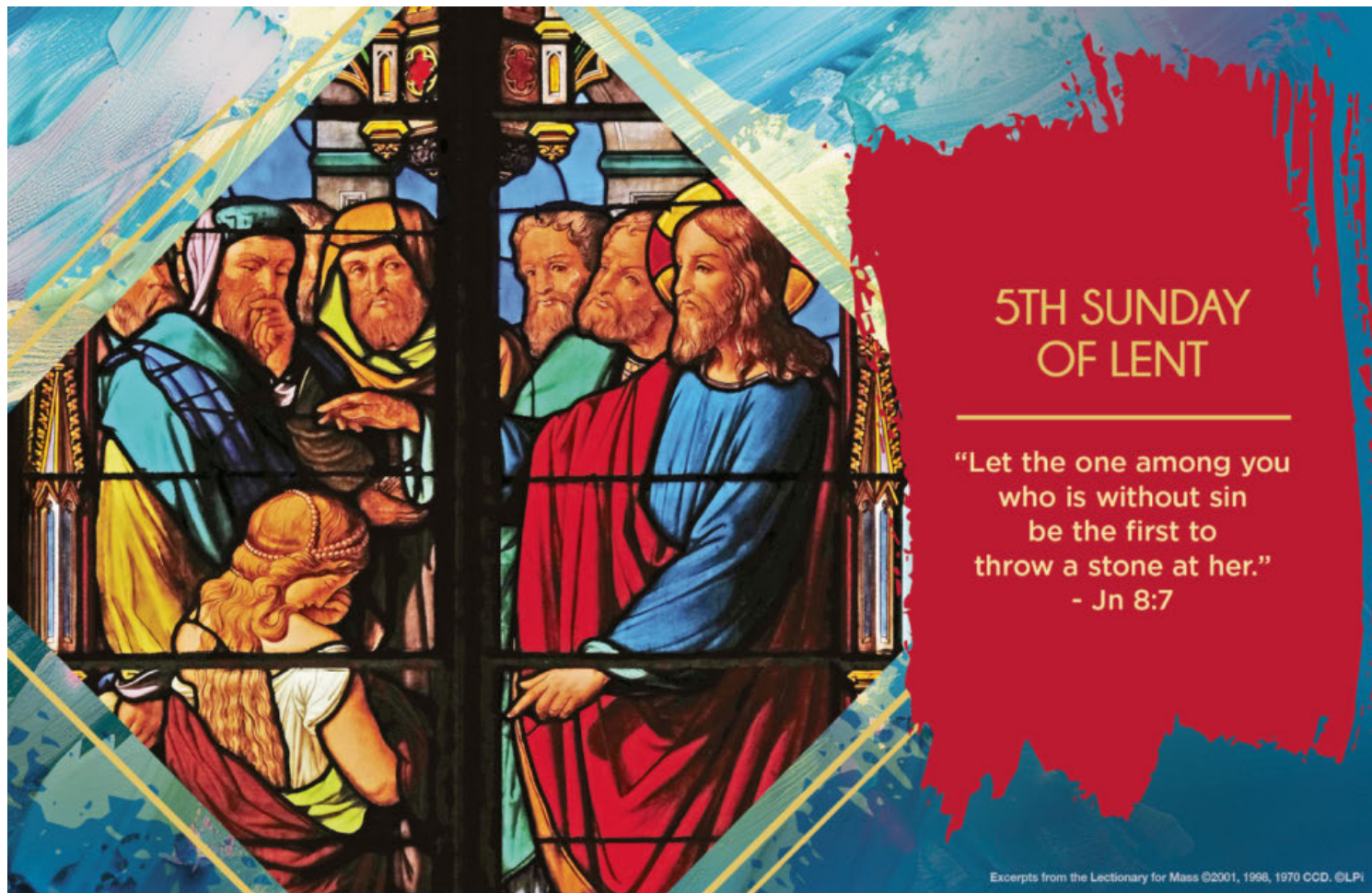

A Message from

SR. MARY ALYCE

Who Am I to Judge?

Once upon a time there was a king who had four sons. He saw that his chief responsibility was to make sure that his sons grew up with wisdom. So one winter day he said to eldest son, "Look I own a farm in the next village and on that farm there is a huge mango tree. It costs me a great deal to maintain it. I want you to go and examine this tree and make a judgment whether it is worth the investment. I plan to ask your brothers to do the same." So the eldest son went and looked at the tree. When spring came the king sent his second son. He sent his third son in summer and his youngest son in the fall. Then he called the boys together to make their judgment. The eldest son spoke first, "Father," he said, "this tree is nothing more than a barren stump, I would cut it down." The second son had a different opinion, "Father," he said, "the tree is covered with many luxurious leaves and produces much shade, but you would have to weigh whether the shade that is produced is worth the cost of maintenance." The third son sort of agreed with his brother, "I saw beautiful flowers on the tree as well, but father you will have to decide whether you plan to visit this tree and enjoy the flowers. If you choose not to do this, it is probably not worth the cost of maintenance." But the youngest son, the fourth son, disagreed strongly with his brothers. "Father," he said, "I have never seen such huge



and delicious fruit on any tree. It would bring a fortune in the marketplace. I say this tree must be maintained no matter what the cost." The father was satisfied and smiled, "Each of you is correct, for each of you saw the tree at a different time. The lesson is clear – if you wish to be wise, you should withhold your judgment until you have seen the tree in all of its seasons."

How often do we make judgment in a situation when we only know part of the information? Jesus teaches that we should not judge with incomplete information because we may miss some of the abundant fruit of the plant if we don't wait for it. What seems one way today may have a different meaning when all the information is known.

But when Jesus calls us not to judge others, he asks us not to make a final judgment. He tells us that we should not judge not because our judgments are incorrect but because they are

often incomplete. We should not be too quick to write off those whom we dislike or those with whose ideas and actions we disagree. Jesus says that we should postpone final judgment in light of a better vision that might someday come.

This teaching is not easy. Jesus tells us that it is not our role to judge another. Once we have taken steps to protect ourselves and those we love from harm, it is not our role to condemn anyone. Instead we are asked to entrust others to God's care, hoping that what is wrong in their life (or situation) might change and what is barren in their life (or situation) might in time produce fruit. The lesson of the sinful woman in today's gospel teaches us this same lesson. And Pope Francis put it succinctly in 2013 when he said "Who am I to judge?"

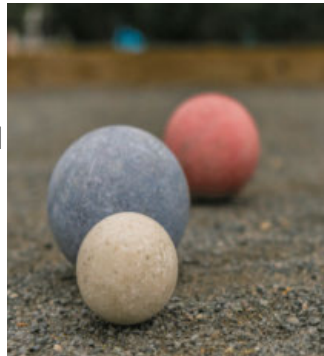
ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA PARISH Bocce League AT ST. LUKE CHURCH

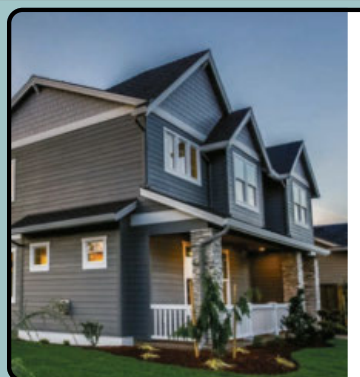



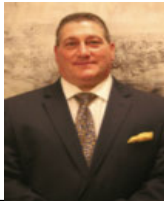
