This weekend we say goodbye to Fr. Steve and send him with God's blessings to his new ministry at St. Rose in Girard and St. Patrick in Hubbard Parishes. No one can deny Fr. Steve's love for the liturgy and his inclusive gestures and greetings throughout the masses that invite each of us to be present to the awesome gift we receive in the Eucharist each time we participate in the prayer of the mass. He has celebrated with us for the past nine months but he has left a lasting impression on us that we will remember. Thank you, Fr. Steve, for your ministry with and to us.

I am extending a special invitation to any men, women or couples that would like to serve as altar servers during masses on Saturdays at 4:30 p.m. The ministry is not difficult and the steps to serving are on cards on the table in front of the window behind the altar. You would not be alone until you are confident in what you are doing. Thank you to John Schiavone and Tony Zeno who are at 4:30 mass each week and who graciously remove the vessels and carry them to the sacristy and purify them for the next mass on Sunday. Charlie has been serving two masses each weekend and now he wants to sing with the choir at mass and give the server's role to someone else. Charlie has been very patient and helpful in training the young altar servers for Sunday liturgies. Most of them are confident enough to do it without Charlie's Guidance now. We appreciate their willingness to step up to assist the priest during liturgies. I want to recognize Derek Linden, our newest adult server. Derek is a student at YSU and he also works so he is not available on Saturday afternoon for mass. You may have seen Derek at the liturgies during Holy Week. I thank him for stepping up to offer his service.

A special word of thanks to Mary Downey for her artistic ability to embroider crosses on the 12 new finger towels we recently purchased for the altar. So now we have finger towels that will correspond to the special liturgical feasts we celebrate: red on Pentecost, purple during Advent and Lent, gold on Christmas and Easter, etc. Just another special touch to add beauty to our liturgical environment. With the refinished chalices that we will have in a few weeks, we will be able to honor Jesus' presence in the Eucharist with special reverence.

Saint Luke Parish received permission from Bishop Bonnar to replace the roof over the west wing of the school. The quoted cost of replacing the flat roof on the school is \$180,219.00. Work will begin in early June when the ECLC students and teachers are out for the summer months.


