

HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY



My friends, it is with great joy that I can announce that Deacon William Wainio, who grow up here at Saint Luke, will be ordained to the Priesthood on Saturday June 1, at the Cathedral of St Columba in Downtown Youngstown. Everyone is invited to attend the ordination Mass at 10:30am on Saturday June 1. The ordination will also be live-streamed on the diocesan website <a href="https://www.doy.org/Videos and Livestream">www.doy.org/Videos and Livestream</a> for those who cannot attend the Ordination Mass. Fr. William Wainio will return here to Saint Luke to celebrate Mass on Sunday June 16th, 2024 at 10AM. Everyone is welcome to join Fr. Wainio, his parents Cyndi and Bert Wainio, and our parish community as we celebrate the gift of his priesthood which no doubt was nourished and influenced here at Saint Luke.

I couldn't help but reflect on the "I Am" Scriptures from the last few weekends. Father Steve alluded to them in his homily last weekend: "I am the Good Shepherd", "I am the Vine, you are the branches", and today, "Remain in my love, i.e., connected to Me". Jesus invites each of us to be with him throughout our lives and our response to our Baptismal call is to not only know Him, but to follow Him by our words and most especially our actions. These actions are a direct outgrowth of the love we share with Jesus and our brothers and sisters because we are all connected to the Source of that Love...God. Each of us a part of all those people and experiences we have encountered throughout our lives. May we continue to be messengers (evangelizers) of the Love we have been invited to share that is, the Love of the Father and Son, to which we belong and in which we share.

In two weeks we will be celebrating our parish at Spring Thing 2024. There is a flyer in today's bulletin outlining the events of the day beginning with 10:00 mass. May 19 is the Feast of Pentecost, too, so our liturgy is a fitting beginning to the continuation of the celebration that will move to the parking lot after mass. As in the past, if you bring a dish that needs to be refrigerated or kept warm, you may drop it off before mass in the parish hall kitchen (not the MMR) or, since there is time between the mass and the serving time, you may choose to drive home after mass to pick up your dish and bring it back with you for the picnic. We plan to eat about 12:30 p.m.

The Saint Luke Altar Rosary Society is partnering with the local Making Kids Count organization by collecting diapers during the month of May. This is one of their outreach projects to the community. Every day, thousands of mothers struggle to afford enough diapers to keep their babies clean and healthy. One in two families requires assistance with diapering their babies. Across multiple states, diaper banks and organizations have united to collect diapers to aid those in need. In our community, the MKC goal is 100,000 diapers. You are invited to join this historic journey to support moms and babies in our own local community. For the next two weekends there will be collection boxes in the narthex for you to leave your donation of diapers of any amount. They are especially in need of sizes 4, 5 and 6 for bigger infants. They will accept whatever size packages you can donate, even clean undamaged diapers in opened packages. Thank you for whatever help you can offer.






