A Message from DEACON MIKE

WHAT REALLY MATTERS

There is an old saying that you can't judge a book by its' cover. You depend on the cover art work or quick blurbs about or quotes from the book and think this is going to be a winner. Wrong! Once you get into it, you become surprised and disappointed at how bad it really it is. Externals did not match the interior, but what really matters?

Yes, looks can be deceiving but in a surprising way. In my last year of teaching (over 20 years ago now), there was a student at the high school who went full goth mode-the black clothes, the 'hairstyle', the spiked necklace, the dark eyeliner and black lip color, He volunteered to help out at the elementary building next door. I checked in on him; We couldn't have been more wrong about him. He was fantastic with those youngsters! He got them to pay attention to what they were to be doing by showing how much he cared that they be successful. Externals did not match the internal, but what really matters?

In the first reading from Acts, the crowds (and we) are amazed at the external signs – a noise like a strong wind (which represented God), tongues of fire (representing the new covenant) and the apostles speaking in different tongues and the people understanding them. Impressive, but is that what really mattered?

A little further in Acts (2:37) we read "Now when they heard this, they (the crowd) were cut to the heart." They wondered what to do next and we then read about 3000 being baptized that day, That's what really mattered. All those externals did what they were meant to do, cause an internal change that changed their lives forever. The work of the Holy Spirit is not in what we see, but



what goes on inside. We will have that 'aha' moment, when all we've seen, heard, and experienced makes sense. We come to realize that belonging to a Church does not make us Christian; how we live outside the building is what really matters.

Notice how at that particular Pentecost, they had gathered as a community of frightened, hiding individuals, wondering what comes next. The Holy Spirit did not come at different times to different individuals but at once to all gathered, and each understood what it meant then to be his follower. They learned being a community of believers let them draw strength together.

We gather as a community sometimes frightened, hiding, wondering what comes next.

While the externals of gathering as one are important, that's not all that matters. We need to gather to be strengthened not only by the Holy Spirit but by one another as well, to have our own 'aha' moment where what's inside of us matters more than what we do on the outside.

Remember I said you can't judge a book by its' cover? I take it back; there is one book you can judge by its' cover, the Bible. It's so much more than Basic Instructions
Before Leaving Earth. It's God's eternal Word, where Blessed Intimacy Begets Life Everlasting. That really matters!
