A Message from DN. BOB

Unless you're a very recent first communicant, if I were to ask you how many times you have received the Body and Blood of Christ in communion during your lifetime, it would be difficult to answer because those occasions have been too numerous to recount. So, I'll ask you a different question, instead. How many times have you given of yourself in love to others as the Body and Blood of Christ? Ideally the answer to that question would exceed the answer to the first question.

When we give of ourselves to others as the Body of Christ, we are responding to the command that Jesus gives to us in today's gospel reading when he says to us: "Give them some food yourselves." God has a long tradition of feeding His people in abundance, at times and in places where people need it the most and have access to it the least. And God uses us, his children, who are the Body and Blood of Christ, to nourish others.

In today's gospel reading, the twelve disciples learned that what matters is placing our resources into the hands of God to help others. In doing so there will always be enough for everyone. The feeding of the five thousand-plus on the deserted hillside can be likened as an image of a Table of Plenty, which is a hymn that we sing at many of our liturgies. With our cooperation, God will provide for all that we need.

Of course, I'm talking about more than just food and drink. The Eucharist we share as a meal is a relationship to be celebrated not only with the Real Presence of Jesus, but with all of our sisters and brothers. As a meal, Eucharist is the single-most important thing we do as Catholic Christians. In the larger context, it is the Body of Christ (who we are) eating



and drinking the Body of Christ (who we are becoming). It was St Augustine who said "Receive what you are, become what you receive."

As mature Christians, we're beyond asking what happens to the bread and wine, and about how and when they become the Body and Blood of Christ. We are past that. The essential Eucharistic question to ask is "what's happening to us; how are we being changed?" So, come to the feast of heaven and earth – come to the table of plenty. But then, go out into the world and give them some food yourselves" – give to those in need the bread that is you; give to the world the bread that is us. For if we claim to be followers of Christ and come to communion without the vision of Jesus, or without any sense of being a community, then what are we becoming? If we receive

the Body of Christ in the Eucharist and ignore others as part of Christ's body, then what are we accomplishing?

Modern-day Franciscan priest, mystic, and spiritual writer, Richard Rohr, writes that "It is marvelous that God would enter our lives not just in the form of sermons or Bibles, but as ingested food and drink." As you contemplate that, keep this in mind. The God who comes to us at every Eucharist as real food and drink is the same God who asks us "when I was hungry, when I was thirsty, when I was homeless – did you help me?" So, may the real food and drink that we provide to others away from the Eucharistic table at Mass, demonstrate to the world the power of the Eucharist to change us, and to change God's kingdom here on earth.
