St. Luke Prayer Chain

Intercessory Prayer has been a hallmark of St. Catherine of Siena Parish even before St. Luke and St. Charles churches merged. Each week there is a growing list of Prayer Requests in the parish bulletin. This list is "open" to requests from both churches. Information for adding a name is printed each week in the bulletin below the Prayer List.

St. Luke Church has an email Prayer Chain that is emailed to "pray-ers", i.e., individuals who pray for the intentions on the Prayer Chain as requests are received. To add the name of a person who needs prayers for surgery, emergency health issues, or other immediate needs, call the St. Luke campus 330-782-9783 to add a name or intention. Explicit medical details do not need to be included for privacy reasons. These prayer requests are emailed to the Prayer Chain as they are received.
