A Message from DEACON BOB

Abraham and Sarah. Martha, Mary, Jesus – and us. Whenever we read or listen to a story in scripture, it's often helpful to place ourselves into the story and to contemplate and imagine ourselves as being one or another of the characters in the story.

Can you see yourself as Sarah or Abraham? Hospitality is a central theme throughout the scriptures. In this weekend's first reading from Genesis, when Abraham saw three men standing nearby, he ran from the entrance of his tent to greet them. Then, he instructed his wife, Sarah, to prepare a meal for them to eat, and they sat and ate while Abraham waited on them. Where are you in the story?

Hospitality. Jesus entered a village where a woman whose name was Martha welcomed him. Then Martha went off to prepare a meal for Jesus and his disciples. Martha's sister, Mary, sat with the disciples while Martha waited on everyone. Where are you in the story? Are you sitting and listening like Mary and the disciples? Are you preparing a meal for others, like Martha? Or are you, like Jesus, teaching and encouraging the disciples?

As you entered the church today you were likely greeted by one or more people. Then you sat (like Mary) and listened to God's word, as you awaited the meal that Jesus prepares



for us at each Mass.

As you came to church today, were you drawn here by the opportunity to sit in the presence of Jesus and listen to him? Were you drawn here to share the Body and Blood of Jesus at the Eucharistic table? Maybe both – a win-win opportunity. But as you walked in the door, were you (like Martha), anxious and worried about many things? Either way, you're in the right place.

The "right place" in our spiritual lives is to listen carefully to Jesus through prayer and contemplation, to participate in the sacramental life of the Church, and then to go out and demonstrate our faith through Christian action. Sit and listen, participate and reflect, but then "act." Following Jesus must lead to action. Following Jesus is to work for civil and human rights.

Following Jesus is to promote justice and peace in the midst of oppression and inequity.

Martha and Mary are two sides of the same coin. Both sisters loved Jesus. Martha demonstrated her love through practical service. Mary demonstrated her love by sitting at Jesus' feet and listening. There's a time to do both – there's a need to do both.

Embracing Change: A Journey of Growth

NEW PARISH ENVELOPES BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER



In mid-August, parishioners of St. Catherine of Siena will receive their new monthly envelope packets. While the envelopes may appear slightly different, our goal is to assist you in understanding the purpose of each envelope as we move forward as one parish. We will continue to explain the monthly envelopes as we move forward. September Envelopes will include the following:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. It will include checkboxes for you to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

- **a. Early Childhood Learning Center -** These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.
- **b. Security -** Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.
- **c. Capital Fund -** Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. St. Vincent de Paul Envelope

This envelope will be distributed quarterly and will feature two checkboxes: one for the St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Chapter and another for the St. Luke St. Vincent de Paul Chapter. Funds collected will support the mission of St. Vincent de Paul in the Mahoning County.

4. CCD Envelope

This envelope will be sent out once a year and will also include two checkboxes: one for St. Charles CCD and one for St. Luke CCD. The funds from these envelopes help offset the supply costs for CCD and religious education.

5. Ladies Guild Envelope

This envelope is just for this year, as next year (in August) there will be a combined envelope for the Altar Rosary Society and Ladies Guild Envelope that requests their yearly dues for both ministries.


