A Message from VALERIE SULLIVAN

"Let the little children come to me & do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these."
Luke 18:16

My family joined St. Luke Church over 30 years ago. Initially, as a teenager, I thought it was strange to go to church in a school gymnasium. I wondered, how it could be church when each week they moved the altar and took down the chairs so the space could be used by the school? How was this church? But then, I came to Mass and participated in the community. That was when I realized that the church isn't about the building...Church is the people who gather in God's name. Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's spirit dwells within you? (1 Corinthians 3:16) The more that I came to church each week, the more I felt connected with my faith and with my larger faith community.

I was blessed to meet my husband, Tom, while volunteering at the St. Luke festival (a long time ago!) working the hoagie booth. We were married 25 years ago and have four children: Kathleen, Faith, Tommy, and Colleen. Our faith has always been the center of our marriage and our family.

As summer is wrapping up and school is beginning, I've been thinking about the important role that we have as parents and as members of our church community. I think back to my younger days and what it was like to bring four little ones to church. We always tried to sit near the back and by the choir. There were many times as a mom that I was anxious and sweating because I didn't want them to be disruptive to those around us. There were many Sundays that I don't remember anything about Mass except that I had to work so hard to keep my kids quiet for an hour.

But, most importantly, I also remember all of the loving people

in my church community who would talk to me after Mass with a smile - they told me how much they loved my children; they were glad that I came to church; they loved watching my family grow. These words of wisdom and faith encouraged me to keep bringing my children to Mass. The smiles and kind words built friendships and - what we call in our house - church family.

Now that my children are older (ages 20, 19, 16, & 14) I think back to those times when they were younger and wondered if it was worth the struggle and stress to come to church each week - and the answer is **YES!** I am proud to watch my children be active members of our church community- volunteering at CCD, being part of our music ministry, being altar servers, and helping whenever or wherever they are needed. Last summer, my husband had surgery and we were not able to attend church for three weeks while he was recovering. But my children woke up each Sunday and went to Mass. I didn't tell them they had to go, quite honestly, we didn't talk about it - they just woke up on Sunday and went to Mass.

I am grateful for the families who

come to church each week. It's not always easy, but it is important. I'm also grateful to those who encouraged me each Sunday when my children were younger. The love and smiles we received made me feel welcome and part of our community. I love watching families come to church. Now since my children are older, I get to be the one who offers smiles and encouragement to parents and families!

As we get to the busy time of year with school starting and sporting activities, I encourage everyone to continue to make Mass a priority. Keep coming, even if it feels hard or stressful at the moment. As parents, we are the first teachers to our children. "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old, he will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6). As Catholics, let's keep building a community where *All are Welcome* and everyone feels connected. Let's all work together to continue to grow our faith, our Church, and our parish family.

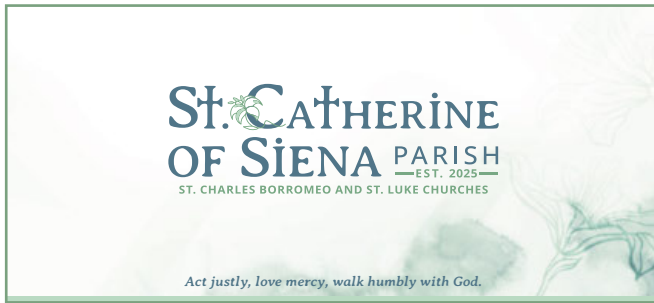

Embracing Change: A Journey of Growth

NEW PARISH ENVELOPES BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER



In mid-August, parishioners of St. Catherine of Siena will receive their new monthly envelope packets. While the envelopes may appear slightly different, our goal is to assist you in understanding the purpose of each envelope as we move forward as one parish. We will continue to explain the monthly envelopes as we move forward.

September Envelopes will include the following:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of

both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. It will include checkboxes for you to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

a. Early Childhood Learning Center - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

b. Security - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.

c. Capital Fund - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. St. Vincent de Paul Envelope

This envelope will be distributed quarterly and will feature two checkboxes: one for the St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Chapter and another for the St. Luke St. Vincent de Paul Chapter. Funds collected will support the mission of St. Vincent de Paul in the Mahoning County.

4. CCD Envelope

This envelope will be sent out once a year and will also include two checkboxes: one for St. Charles CCD and one for St. Luke CCD. The funds from these envelopes help offset the supply costs for CCD and religious education.

5. Ladies Guild Envelope

This envelope is just for this year, as next year (in August) there will be a combined envelope for the Altar Rosary Society and Ladies Guild Envelope that requests their yearly dues for both ministries.

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

As we continue to foster the unity of our parish community, we are seeking volunteers to support this essential ministry at both St. Charles and St. Luke Church. The bereavement minister accompanies the family during their time of immense grief and guides them through the planning of the funeral Mass. The Bereavement Ministry serves as a bridge between St. Catherine of Siena Parish and the grieving family, providing assistance and ongoing support to those who have experienced a loss.
