A Message from DAVE FELDEN

SUMMER VACATION?

At the end of the last school year, a parishioner came up to me and remarked, "I bet you're glad to have summers off." I looked at the person with a puzzled look which garnered their next statement. "Well after all, you guys are on vacation with the teachers." What many do not know is that summers are the busiest time of the year for the St. Catherine/St. Charles maintenance crew. In addition to the daily general building and grounds maintenance for the school and church, the school gets special attention.

SCHOOL WORK: Every year, there is a ten week "summer vacation" window where the following work is performed. The first day after the teachers leave, prior to being emptied, all classrooms are documented with photos. A four-man crew (two full-time and two summer helpers) then get to work. All items in the classrooms are moved off the floor and into the school hallways. Once all rooms are emptied, our contractor, Imperial Service Systems, proceeds with scrubbing and waxing all classroom floors. Floor waxing is contracted, allowing the maintenance crew to concentrate on other activities. As part of an original five-year plan, selected rooms are updated from fluorescent to LED lighting. The LED lighting provides a brighter atmosphere in the classroom as well as decreased maintenance. Rugs and carpets in the individual rooms are cleaned. The hallway walls are repaired and painted as needed. Classroom lockers are cleaned, repaired, and painted as required. Student desks are cleaned and repaired. All classroom heating units are cleaned including replacing the air filters. After all classroom work is completed, the rooms are reassembled using the original photos taken. Once the hallways are cleared and classrooms are put back together, Imperial Service Systems proceeds with scrubbing and waxing the hallways and restrooms. All the above, occurs every summer. In addition to the yearly summertime work routine, there are also "special projects."

CLASSROOM AIR CONDITIONING:

If you ever visited the classrooms during the hot days of early and late summer, you know it can get

quite warm creating a less than comfortable atmosphere for learning. A project that has been in the works for years is now completed. York-Mahoning and Santon Electric were contracted to install individual air conditioners in each of the classrooms. The units are heat pump mini splits which will be able to run as air conditioners in the summers and heaters. The expectation is that the existing steam and hot water boiler systems will not be the primary source of heat, but act as supplement. In other words, for the first time since the building of the school, the classrooms will be air conditioned.

SCHOOL PARKING LOT AND STEPS:

Parking lots and concrete steps do not last a lifetime. Lindy Paving and Superior Concrete were contracted to replace the school parking lot, as well as several concrete pads and the main school steps. Two inches of pavement was ground off the existing school parking lot and stone base was added where required. The lot was then paved. As part of the paving the entry and exit areas were modified to allow for more cars to be in the school parking lot for children "drop offs" and "pick ups." Concrete sidewalk sections and steps which had deteriorated were removed, formed, and re-poured.

SCHOOL ENTRY BEAUTIFICATION:

Electrical runs for the new air conditioning allowed for the removal of dying bushes and for additional re-landscaping. Carano Lawn Care & Landscaping was contracted to dress up the Westview and church sides of the school.

CHURCH STEEPLE ROOF: The original steeple roof consisted of cement shingles weighing up to ten pounds each. The height of the steeple and nature of the work limited the contractor pool. Prime Commercial Roofing proposed a unique costeffective approach. The extreme heat and rain forcast caused several delays. Eventually, skilled workers were able to remove the old concrete shingles and old firring strips and install a new asphalt shingle roofing system.

SCHOOL CAMERA SECURITY & DOOR ACCESS SYSTEM UPGRADE:

Keeping the school a safe place for the students and teachers is the highest priority. Buckeye I.T. was contracted to upgrade the security camera system. The old system although state of the art at the time of installation, was outdated and starting to fail. A higher resolution with additional monitoring points were installed. The door access system, again state of the art when installed, was outdated and starting to fail. The upgrade allows for more flexibility and time restrictions.

PLUMBING: Galloway construction was contracted to repair two major plumbing issues in the second-floor student restroom. The leaks were significant enough that professional plumbers were required to facilitate the repairs.

CHURCH FIRE ALARM SYSTEM UPGRADE: Keeping our place of worship is also a very high priority. University Electric was contracted to replace the fire alarm system in the church. The old system began to fail with replacement components not available. The replacement system uses cellular technology to communicate to the monitoring station. The new system also allows for continuing improvements as individual sensors expire or fail.

MISCELLANEOUS PROJECTS: While coordinating the contract work the maintenance crew performed various repair and painting projects at the church and school. Gutter cleaning along with numerous other miscellaneous projects were also completed.

THANK YOU: Many thanks to all parishioners who continuously support these projects through prayers and generous financial contributions. It is only through your generosity that these many projects can be done.

Thanks to the St. Catherine/St. Charles maintenance crew for a summer of hard work and thanks to all the contractors. I would like to extend a very special thank you to the church volunteer(s) who helped all summer long vacuuming the church, which allowed maintenance to concentrate on the many other projects.

So, it has been a very busy but fruitful summer...and through it all God kept watch...keeping us all safe, encouraging us, and allowing us to accomplish all the work timely and without issue.

NEW PARISH ENVELOPES BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER



In mid-August, parishioners of St. Catherine of Siena will receive their new monthly envelope packets. While the envelopes may appear slightly different, our goal is to assist you in understanding the purpose of each envelope as we move forward as one parish. We will continue to explain the monthly envelopes as we move forward.

September Envelopes will include the following:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of

both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. It will include checkboxes for you to indicate where you wish your donation to go: **a. Early Childhood Learning Center -** These funds support the administrative costs

a. Early Childhood Learning Center - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

b. Security - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.

c. Capital Fund - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. St. Vincent de Paul Envelope

This envelope will be distributed quarterly and will feature two checkboxes: one for the St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Chapter and another for the St. Luke St. Vincent de Paul Chapter. Funds collected will support the mission of St. Vincent de Paul in the Mahoning County.

4. CCD Envelope

This envelope will be sent out once a year and will also include two checkboxes: one for St. Charles CCD and one for St. Luke CCD. The funds from these envelopes help offset the supply costs for CCD and religious education.

5. Ladies Guild Envelope

This envelope is just for this year, as next year (in August) there will be a combined envelope for the Altar Rosary Society and Ladies Guild Envelope that requests their yearly dues for both ministries.






