A Message from LAURA KUNKEL

"Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all the earth. Make a loud noise and rejoice and sing praise." Psalm 98:4

The call to make a joyful noise is not limited to a specific group but is a universal invitation, reflecting the inclusivity of worship. In biblical times, joyful noise often included singing, shouting, and playing musical instruments, as seen in 2 Samuel 6:5. When David and the Israelites celebrated before the Lord with all different types of instruments. Singing praises is a central element of worship throughout the Bible, reflecting both personal devotion and communal celebration. The act of singing is always a good way to recount God's deeds, express gratitude, and declare His attributes.

Growing up, I was a parishioner of Saint Mary's Catholic Church in Mineral Ridge, Ohio, where my grandmother was the Music Director. As a little girl, I would sit up in the choir loft with her, admiring how beautifully she would play the organ, and sing for our Lord. I watched her lead the adult choir and the children's choir that I was also a part of. Being an angel for the Nativity on Christmas Eve is one of my favorite memories. From that moment on, I knew music ministry within the Catholic Church was going to be an important part of my future. I always felt so close to God by serving Him, leading our parish in worship through song.



Since I felt God's call to do music ministry full time, I began cantoring at Mass at St. Edward in Youngstown. Eventually, my ministry evolved into a music director position at St. Edward with Msgr. Siffrin. In my many years in music ministry I have witnessed and encountered choir members who have lifted their voices in praise for the glory of God which has transformed their faith life, as well as their excitement for Sunday worship. In addition to their faith, it has also brought them together in community.

As Saint Augustine said, "He who sings prays twice." The choir isn't just about music; it's about serving God and leading our parish in worship. Our parish choirs are always looking for new members. No professional training needed, just a love for music, and a desire to praise God. Our adult choir sings at 9:00 a.m. Mass every Sunday, Midnight Mass

on Christmas Eve, the Easter Vigil Mass, and other Holy Day Masses. Our children's choir sings every other Sunday at 11:30 a.m. Mass, 4:00 p.m. Christmas Eve, and 11:30 a.m. Easter Sunday. At the alternate 11:30 a.m. Masses we will have some of our older and more advanced children singing. Why should you or your children join the choir? To glorify God, uplift our parish family, and grow in faith through music.

Stewardship Reflection

Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you." Luke 14:13-14

One of the main principles of living a stewardship lifestyle is to give without expecting anything in return. This is difficult for some to comprehend in our "consumerist" culture that we live in. This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish. Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.

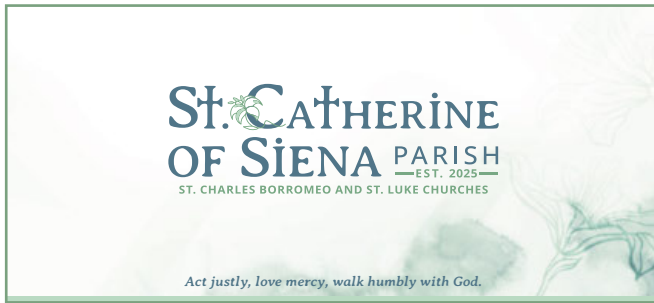

Embracing Change: A Journey of Growth

NEW PARISH ENVELOPES BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER



You should have received your new monthly envelope packets. While the envelopes may appear slightly different, our goal is to assist you in understanding the purpose of each envelope as we move forward as one parish. We will continue to explain the monthly envelopes as we move forward.

September Envelopes will include the following:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. It will include checkboxes for you to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

a. Early Childhood Learning Center - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

b. Security - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.

c. Capital Fund - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. St. Vincent de Paul Envelope

This envelope will be distributed quarterly and will feature two checkboxes: one for the St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Chapter and another for the St. Luke St. Vincent de Paul Chapter. Funds collected will support the mission of St. Vincent de Paul in the Mahoning County.

4. CCD Envelope

This envelope will be sent out once a year and will also include two checkboxes: one for St. Charles CCD and one for St. Luke CCD. The funds from these envelopes help offset the supply costs for CCD and religious education.

5. Ladies Guild Envelope

This envelope is just for this year, as next year (in August) there will be a combined envelope for the Altar Rosary Society and Ladies Guild Envelope that requests their yearly dues for both ministries.

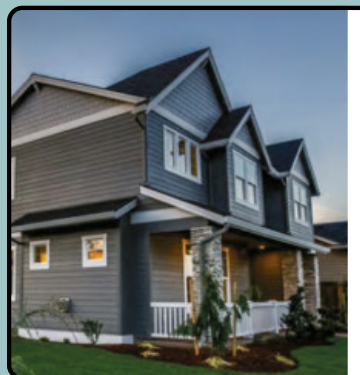

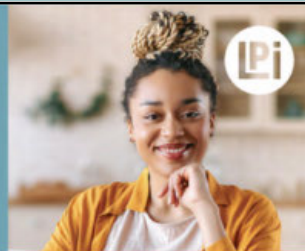

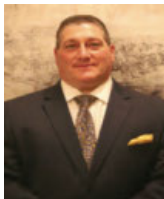
