

## A Message from STEVEN VASKO

Happy 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. My name is Steven Vasko I am a parishioner here at St. Catherine of Siena Parish. I am currently in my fourth year of seminary studying to one day be, God willing, a Catholic priest. I wanted to take a moment to share a little about my seminary experience over the last year.

During the last year I was involved in a program called the Propaedeutic Year. The word propaedeutic literally means pre-school. The goal of the year was to stop taking classes and take a deep dive into discernment.

The process of doing this deep dive included several key things. One was a technology and commerce fast. We would not have access to our phone or any media from Sunday till Friday and the same was true of making purchases. Another key detail of the year was different experiences, such as a poverty immersion where I was given \$50.00 and a bus ticket to Washington D.C. and back. During that time I lived in a capuchin seminary and met so many lovely people around D.C. We also had an eight day silent retreat in February where I was given the chance to spend every day in silence with four holy hours.

The culminating event was our pilgrimage to Santiago De Compostella. This pilgrimage is known as the Camino. It served as a perfect wrap up of the Propaedeutic Year. Over the course of my 500 mile 33 day hike I met so many people who had similar desires to myself. They all wanted to slow down and understand their place in the world. They wanted

to grow deeper in faith and I even met a few fellow men who were discerning a call to the priesthood as well. The Camino really pushed me to put everything I had learned over the last year into practice. I would start the day at six to manage to get into town before the sun had reached its peak. I had to learn how to turn my walk into prayer, and when I got to town I was faced with a decision. I could either vege out on my bed and watch YouTube all day, or I could embrace what I had learned from the year, and leave my phone behind and go meet more people. Everytime I chose to go meet people I found that I was fulfilled and had fantastic conversations. If I ever fell back into old habits I would feel terrible and quickly put down my phone to go find community.

I think the Camino is a great example of everyday life. While we are not hiking 15 miles every day, we are forced with decisions that can bring us

closer to life. A life with Christ is not a life where you spend eight hours a day in front of the Blessed Sacrament, but rather spending little moments in reflection and spending time with your loved ones and neighbors. It is spent listening to where the Holy Spirit guides you for that day and giving all of your effort for Him. Even when you are at work, or walking, giving Him all of your efforts will fulfill you. That is what I found fulfillment in this last year and especially on the Camino.

Know that I will be praying for all of you and I ask that you pray for me as I continue formation into the man Christ desires me to be.

## **Embracing Change: A Journey of Growth**

### **NEW PARISH ENVELOPES BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER**



You should have recieved your new monthly envelope packets. While the envelopes may appear slightly different, our goal is to assist you in understanding the purpose of each envelope as we move forward as one parish. We will continue to explain the monthly envelopes as we move forward.

September Envelopes will include the following:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. It will include checkboxes for you to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

**a. Early Childhood Learning Center -** These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

**b. Security -** Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.

**c. Capital Fund -** Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. St. Vincent de Paul Envelope

This envelope will be distributed quarterly and will feature two checkboxes: one for the St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Chapter and another for the St. Luke St. Vincent de Paul Chapter. Funds collected will support the mission of St. Vincent de Paul in the Mahoning County.

4. CCD Envelope

This envelope will be sent out once a year and will also include two checkboxes: one for St. Charles CCD and one for St. Luke CCD. The funds from these envelopes help offset the supply costs for CCD and religious education.

5. Ladies Guild Envelope

This envelope is just for this year, as next year (in August) there will be a combined envelope for the Altar Rosary Society and Ladies Guild Envelope that requests their yearly dues for both ministries.






