A Message from TERESA YARGER

The main entrance of St. Charles School has the following words from Matthew's Gospel hanging over it, "Wherever 2 or 3 are gathered in my name, there I am in the midst of them."

These words greet our faculty, students, parents, and visitors as they enter our building. They remind us of our Mission and of the constant presence of Jesus in our lives. From the moment the first bell rings to start the day to the time when the last student in line leaves at dismissal, we offer all that we do for the greater glory of God.

To kick off the school year, my faculty participated in a day-long retreat at Trilogy Retreat Property in Southington, Ohio. The day centered around the themes of Catholic Social Teaching with a specific focus on our Diocesan theme, "Seek the welfare of the city...pray for it to the LORD." (Jeremiah 29:7) In the course of the day, teachers were taught methods of sharing Principles of Social Justice with their students. We shared, reviewed, and learned many ways we can show our students how to be better stewards of God's creation and kinder more compassionate members of our community. We were reminded that caring for one another starts small in our classrooms with our peers and filters out into the surrounding

We learned a great deal that day and we have brought back many ideas that are already taking shape in our classrooms.

I'd like to share three examples of how we are teaching our students to live the way that Jesus intended. This week, I was visiting a Second Grade classroom. Their Religion lesson was focused on things that they could do to help others. The first student said that we needed to treat others the way that we want to be treated. This basic



principle of human solidarity and concern for others guided all of their thoughts and answers. They shared hand-drawn pictures of them doing their chores to help their parents, getting a snack from the fridge for their younger siblings, helping a classmate with their seatwork, and calling their grandma on the phone to tell her that they love her. In simple ways, they were spreading God's message of seeking the welfare of others.

The fifth graders showed another concrete example of this in their math class. They were learning about exponents. The lesson consisted of them watching a famous YouTuber who is promoting a clean water campaign throughout the world. The lesson shows how every donation of \$1, when joined with all of the other \$1 donations, can provide clean water for millions of people around the globe. #teamwater is the largest campaign for clean water in the world and it is based upon the principle that every little action counts for something and that the smallest donation, when combined with others, can really have a monumental impact. The fifth grade students learned that they too, through their small efforts, can make a difference in the lives of others.

The final example is from our

first service project of the year. Our Eighth Graders provide many opportunities for service in preparation for their Confirmation. Their first project is in partnership with a St. Charles graduate, Grace. The students are collecting new blankets to be distributed to local shelters on behalf of the "Warmed by Grace" project. This is a wonderful opportunity for our St. Charles School family to help and serve the community. It is a perfect example of Catholic teaching of the option for the poor and vulnerable and care for all members of the community. Our students are working together to make the world a better place. They are learning that helping others is what God intends for us to do. They are making a difference now so that they can grow to be examples of Christ for one another in the future.

At St. Charles School, we know that when we gather, God is in the midst of us. We also know that it is our responsibility to take what we learn and use it to make the world a better place. Pray for us, as we will continue to pray for all of the members of St. Catherine of Siena Parish.

PARISH ENVELOPES FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER

You should have received your new monthly envelope packets for September.

If you haven't received them and would like to, or if you have received the envelopes but do not wish to, please contact the parish office so we can address the issue.

Our aim is to help you understand the purpose of each envelope as we progress together as one parish.

October Envelopes will include the following:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. Please maks sure you mark the checkboxes to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

- **a. Early Childhood Learning Center -** These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.
- **b. Security -** Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.
- **c. Capital Fund -** Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. Educational Endowment Fund

This envelope will be distributed every quarter, and the funds collected will be deposited into a designated bank account to assist in covering tuition costs for St. Charles School.

4. World Mission Sunday Grey Envelope

Observed annually on the second-to-last Sunday of October, World Mission Sunday is a day when Catholics worldwide come together to support the Church's missionary efforts. On this day, every parish, in every diocese, across all countries, unites in prayer and contributions to ensure that missionaries can persist in their essential work—building churches, training priests, supporting catechists, and aiding communities in need. Please note, this envelope will only be distributed once a year.

5. All Saints Day

This envelope is only once a year for All Saints Day. This year, All Saints Day falls on a Saturday and is not a Holy Day of Obligation. The monies collected go toward the general fund.

6. All Souls Day

This envelope is distributed only once a year for All Souls Day. This year, the names of the departed submitted with the envelopes will be featured in the bulletin on Sunday, November 2, in honor of the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. To ensure the names are included in the bulletin, please return the envelopes NO LATER THAN Sunday, October 19, 2025. In addition to being published, the envelopes will be placed in a position of honor near the altar throughout the month of November.
