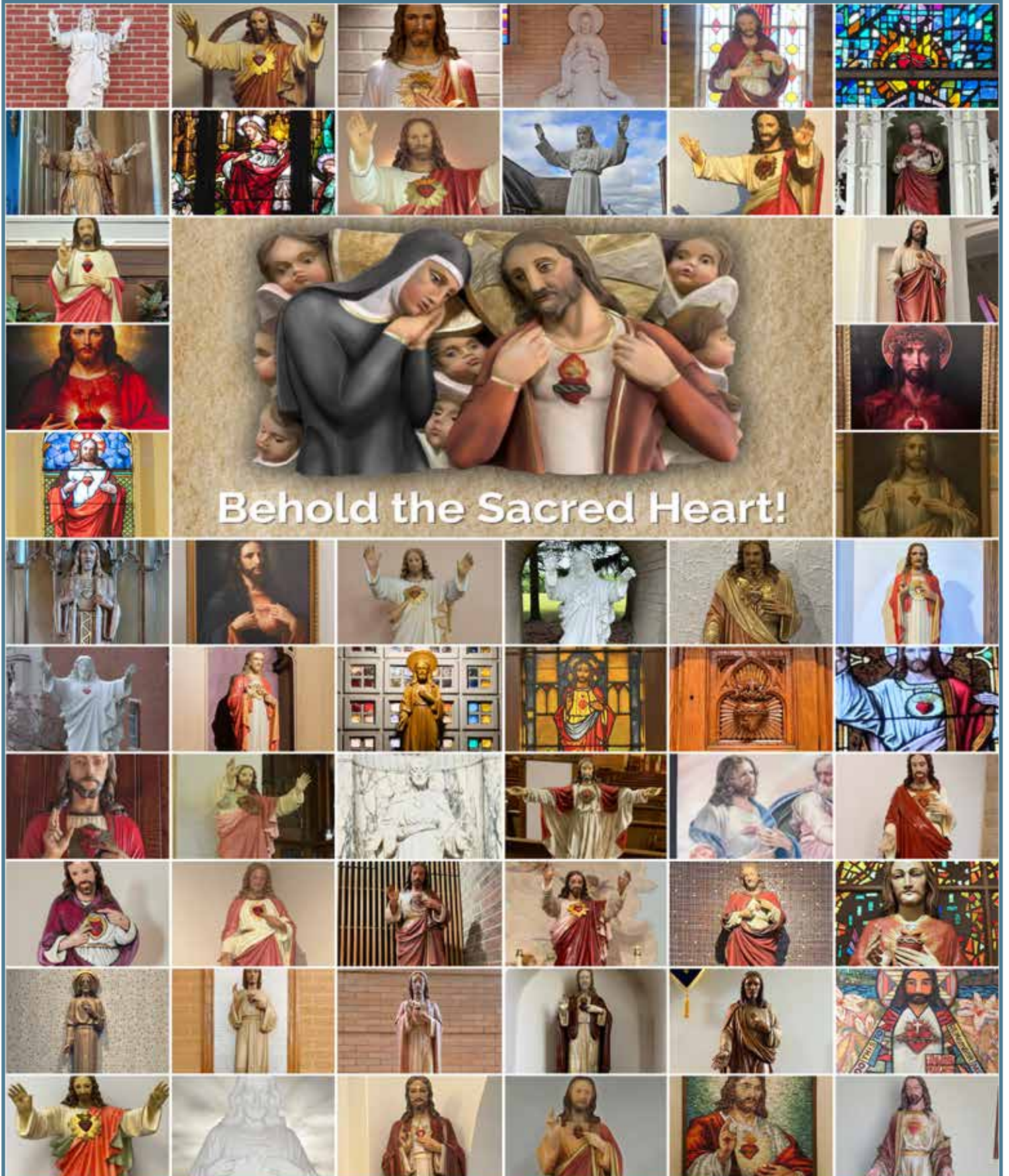

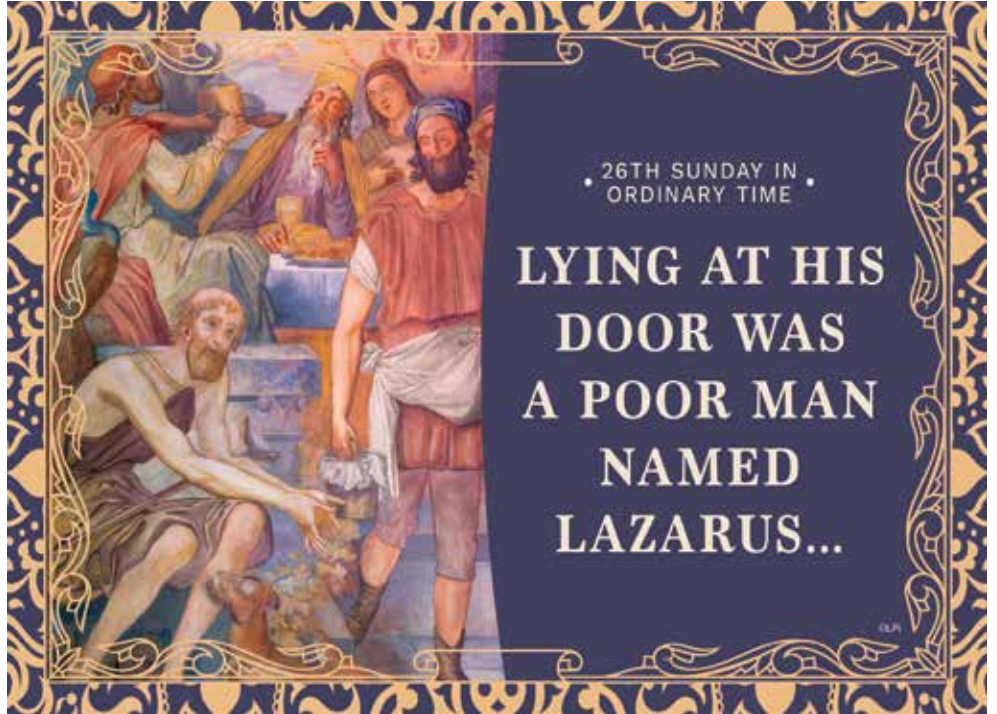

## A Message from DN. BOB REDIG

I will probably never own a ring doorbell. The technology behind them is impressive, but their usefulness is somewhat limited. By that, I mean that one can only see what is right in front of the doorbell. I'm not knocking a Ring doorbell. Rather, I'm just thinking that Christians (and all God's children) are called to "see" through a wider lens; a lens that allows love and compassion to enhance our vision.

Instead of a Ring doorbell, God placed a poor man, Lazarus, in the doorway of the rich man in today's gospel. Covered with sores and in the company of dogs who licked his wounds, the rich man nevertheless still failed to "see" Lazarus – until it was too late; until their fortunes were reversed. In today's world, there is obviously a great chasm (to quote the gospel terminology) between the very rich and the very poor; between opposite ends of the social spectrum. Even within our own smaller social circles, we sometimes fail to truly notice the needs of one another. Even though we can be physically close to the people we know, there can be a great divide between us. And if we are failing to notice the needs of those who are near to us, then we're probably not looking through a wider lens that enables us to see the crushing needs of the world



around us.

We can be overwhelmed by the sheer scale of the inequities that exist in God's kingdom on earth. We can throw our hands in the air and say "what can I do, or what can we do?" But there is always something we can do, no matter how seemingly small it seems to be, that will make a difference. Lazarus would have been happy to eat the scraps that fell from the rich man's table; those scraps would have made a significant difference in his life. But do you know what else? Even the smallest gesture of compassion by the rich man, one that would have recognized the dignity of the beggar at his door, could have made a huge difference in his life as well.

Who knows, maybe one small token of kindness would have changed the rich

man's heart and enabled him to step out of his own privileged world, allowing him to enter the world of the other. Being attentive to the suffering of others is a concrete expression of authentic love – of realized grace. Can we embrace that grace?

Who are we? Are we the rich man, or are we the poor man? Actually, we are both. We are the modern-day human faces of both wealth and poverty. We have a choice to be a blessing or a curse for one another. Go make a difference!

*Deuteronomy 30:19: "I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Choose life..."*

### PARISH ENVELOPES FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER

You should have received your new monthly envelope packets for September.

If you haven't received them and would like to, or if you have received the envelopes but do not wish to, please contact the parish office so we can address the issue.

Our aim is to help you understand the purpose of each envelope as we progress together as one parish.

*October Envelopes will include the following:*

#### 1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

#### 2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. Please make sure you mark the checkboxes to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

**a. Early Childhood Learning Center** - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

**b. Security** - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses.

**c. Capital Fund** - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

#### 3. Educational Endowment Fund

This envelope will be distributed every quarter, and the funds collected will be deposited into a designated bank account to assist in covering tuition costs for St. Charles School.

#### 4. World Mission Sunday Grey Envelope

Observed annually on the second-to-last Sunday of October, World Mission Sunday is a day when Catholics worldwide come together to support the Church's missionary efforts. On this day, every parish, in every diocese, across all countries, unites in prayer and contributions to ensure that missionaries can persist in their essential work—building churches, training priests, supporting catechists, and aiding communities in need. Please note, this envelope will only be distributed once a year.

#### 5. All Saints Day

This envelope is only once a year for All Saints Day. This year, All Saints Day falls on a Saturday and is not a Holy Day of Obligation. The monies collected go toward the general fund.

#### 6. All Souls Day

This envelope is distributed only once a year for All Souls Day. This year, the names of the departed submitted with the envelopes will be featured in the bulletin on Sunday, November 2, in honor of the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. To ensure the names are included in the bulletin, please return the envelopes **NO LATER THAN Sunday, October 19, 2025**. In addition to being published, the envelopes will be placed in a position of honor near the altar throughout the month of November.

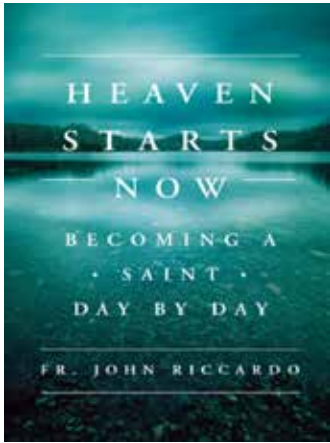
