A Message from LAURA KUNKEL

Gaudete Sunday: When Joy Finds It's Voice

There is a moment in every great piece of music when the melody lifts-subtly at first, then unmistakably- lifting the listener to breathe a little deeper. Advent has its own musical arc, too. For two weeks, we've walked in the quiet rhythm of waiting and repentance, the steady beat of preparing our hearts for Christ. But on this Third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, the music shifts. A new note enters the score: joy.

The word Gaudete means "Rejoice!" It's the same command St. Paul gives with such urgency that you can almost hear the exclamation point: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice!" Joy, for the Christian, is not a response to perfect circumstances. It is the deep, steady harmony that rises from the certainty that the Lord is nearby.

The rose candle we light today is like a change in key, an unexpected brightness. It doesn't erase the slow, solemn tones of the season, but it brings warmth that softens them. In the same way, Christian joy does not deny life's struggles. It sings through them, like a violin line trembling above a minor chord.

This Sunday, the Gospel introduces us again to John the Baptist, a man whose life was filled with joy, not because of who he was, but because of the One he pointed toward.



John's joy was the joy of a herald who's every word was, "Listen! Something beautiful is coming." He is like the first instrument to break the silence before the great symphony begins.

Maybe this is our invitation, too. To be heralds of joy in small, simple ways. To let our lives carry a note of hope that others can hear. Perhaps through a word of kindness, a gesture of patience, a prayer whispered for someone who is hurting. Each one is a measure in the song God is writing in our community.

And so, we pause today in our Advent waiting to rejoice, not

loudly, perhaps, but sincerely. For even in seasons that feel dissonant, Christ is tuning our hearts to His coming grace. Joy is His gift, and His promise.

As we light the rose candle and hear the familiar hymns that lift our spirits this week, may we allow God to draw a new melody out of us, one that carries His joy into every place we go.

Rejoice-the Lord is near. Let your life be a song of that nearness.



Embracing Change: A Journey of Growth



December Envelopes will include:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. Please make sure you mark the checkboxes to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

a. Early Childhood Learning Center - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

b. Security - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses as well help offset the cost for the expenses for other security systems, such as cameras.

c. Capital Fund - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. St. Vincent de Paul Envelope

This envelope is distributed quarterly and features two checkboxes: one for the St. Charles St. Vincent de Paul Chapter and another for the St. Luke St. Vincent de Paul Chapter. Funds collected will support the mission of St. Vincent de Paul in the Mahoning County.

4. Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary Envelope

This envelope is distributed once a year for the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary Mass. The funds collected contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

5. The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God Envelope

This envelope is distributed once a year for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God Mass. The funds collected contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

6. Social Concerns/Martha's Cupboard Envelope

This envelope will be distributed twice a year and will feature two checkboxes: one for Social Concerns and another for Martha's Cupboard. Funds collected will go directly to help those most in need in our community. Please mark which ministry you would like your contribution go towards.

7. Christmas Flowers (November Packet)

This envelope is distributed twice a year, once for Christmas and once for Easter. The funds raised go towards purchasing holiday flowers and other materials to enhance the beauty of the sanctuary throughout the year. **This envelope is due no later than Sunday, December 14 if you would like the names of your loved ones published in the December 28 bulletin.**




Christmas Ornament Fundraiser

The Octave of the Nativity, or Octave of Christmas, is the eight-day period in the Catholic Church that begins on Christmas Day (December 25) and concludes on New Year's Day (January 1) with the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. During this time, the celebration of Christmas is extended to reflect its importance as a major feast, with each day treated as a high-ranking solemnity Mass.




