A Message from DN. BOB REDIG

I remember growing up when our parish bulletin would publish what were called wedding banns on three consecutive weekends. Wedding banns I, II, and III, using Roman Numerals. The weekly banns contained the names of couples who were engaged to be married. At the time, I really had no idea what the purpose of the wedding banns were, but for some reason they interested me, nonetheless. I know now that their purpose was an attempt to uncover any legal or canonical reasons why a couple shouldn't enter into a marriage. I can only imagine that there must have been some couples who would perhaps be nervous that others might come forward to oppose their suitability to be married in the church.

When Matthew composed today's gospel, there were no weekly synagogue bulletins that contained three weeks of wedding banns. There were, however, three stages for Jews getting married in Jesus' time. First there was the engagement, then the betrothal, and finally the wedding. The betrothal was a serious commitment. It was the first part of the marriage. There would be no sexual relationship, as the couple would not yet be living together, but it was a binding relationship. Normal married life began some months later when the husband took his betrothed into his home. To violate the betrothal by having sexual relations with another person was equivalent to adultery.

Imagine, then, the dilemma that Joseph faced. He discovers that the woman to whom he is already betrothed, but with whom he has not consummated their relationship in marriage, is already pregnant. There could be only one explanation - she had been unfaithful and was having another man's child. It was a very serious matter and, if brought out into the open, could have made Mary liable to death by stoning. But Joseph was, as the gospel



says, "righteous man". As a devout follower of the Mosaic Law, he would want to break the union with someone who had so seriously broken the Law. And yet, because he was such a good man, he did not want to expose her to a terrible punishment. In this, for his time, Joseph showed extraordinary restraint and tolerance. Few men would be like Joseph and accept such a situation with such calmness and self-restraint. Most would find it to be an impossible situation.

It is at this point that there is divine intervention and God communicates the true situation to Joseph. He is assured that no other man is involved, and that Mary has conceived through the power of God's Spirit.

And as Matthew liked to do, he shows that all this is in fulfillment of an Old Testament prophecy. We hear that prophecy in today's first reading from Isaiah: "...the Lord himself will give you this sign ...the virgin will conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel." 'Emmanuel' means "God-is-with-us". This will

be re-echoed when, at the very end of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus says to his disciples just before he ascends to his Father: "And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Jesus remains with us forever.

So, Joseph, now at peace, took Mary to his home as his wife. Thus, there is no mistaking the origins of Jesus. He has a human mother, but a divine Father. He will be the perfect Savior of his people - in a fully human person, the power of God himself will be at work.

God still lives with his people. And he does that through the Body of the Risen Jesus, the Church, the Christian community and its communities all over the world. Each one of us is called to be Emmanuel. Through us, people can meet God and hear the message of love and salvation, forgiveness and reconciliation. Let us renew our commitment to be Jesus for the people in our lives.

PARISH ENVELOPES FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY

You should be receiving your monthly envelope packets for January. If you haven't received the new envelopes and would like to, or if you have received the envelopes but do not wish to, please contact the parish office so we can address the issue. Our aim is to help you understand the purpose of each envelope as we progress together as one parish.

January Envelopes will include:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. Please make sure you mark the checkboxes to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

a. Early Childhood Learning Center - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

b. Security - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses as well help offset the cost for the expenses for other security systems, such as cameras.

c. Capital Fund - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. Catholic Echo Magazine Envelope

This envelope is distributed annually to assist in covering the monthly subscription cost for each parishioner to receive the Catholic Echo. We kindly ask for a contribution to help offset this expense.

4. Initial Offering Envelope

This envelope is distributed annually, and the funds collected assist in covering the yearly printing costs.

5. Church Overseas Envelope

This combined collection supports four major overseas services: Catholic Relief Services (CRS), Holy Father/Peter's Pence, the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, and the Church in Latin America.

6. Mens Club/Holy Name Society Envelope

This annual envelope is designed for individuals associated with these specific ministries, allowing them to conveniently pay their yearly dues.

7. Educational Endowment Fund Envelope

This envelope will be distributed every quarter, and the funds collected will be deposited into a designated bank account to assist in covering tuition costs for St. Charles School.

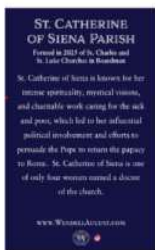


Christmas Ornament Fundraiser

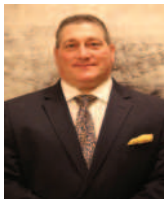
