
A Message from DN. MIKE KOČJANCIC WE ARE FAMILY

Growing up, many people fear becoming like their parents when they have a family. In fact, there's a series of commercials on TV now about how to avoid being your parent.

But is that always a bad thing? I guess it depends on your parents and you.

While both parents play an important part in raising a family, each parent has special gifts they bring to one or the other of the children. Kathy's mom and my dad were great role models for the two of us. From her mom, Kathy learned that family was the most important job. She had always looking out for Kathy and her three siblings. Wasn't easy, but her mom Betty always got it done. Kathy saw this in her mom and she became this in our family. My dad John worked hard his entire life often having two jobs to make ends meet. He never retired, and worked until one month before his passing in 1998 at the age of 77. He always provided for us, AND always made sure that he was there for us. I saw this in my dad and became this (I hope) in my family.

Today's gospel reading comes from the nativity story as found in St. Matthew; only the gospel of St. Luke provides another nativity story. While details may vary, the message is the same in both, as Luke writes in chapter 2:40 "... and the child grew and became strong filled with wisdom...". FYI, if you're trying to find the term 'Holy Family' in scripture, you won't. The descriptive term Holy Family is an extra biblical



tradition, the devotional term used in theology and art to refer to Jesus, Mary, and his earthly father Joseph.

So what exactly did the human side of Jesus learn from Mary and Joseph? They taught him the importance of scripture, traditions, and religious customs. Jesus learned to observe the Jewish feasts, recite the psalms, and regularly attend the synagogue to hear the word of God. Both parents showed how one must be obedient to God even when it may be difficult and confusing. They taught him basic manners, responsibility, and how to interact with others. An unwavering faith and trust in God is the most important trait one can have. Though 100% divine, it was the 100% human side of Jesus that needed Mary and Joseph, and they needed Jesus. The three of them depended on one another and the role they each had to play. What is said about the 'Holy Family' should be said about our own families and also for the church family. From

one another when we gather, we learn scripture, tradition, religious customs, rites where God's word is heard, basic manners, responsibilities, and how to interact with one another. In both our own families and our parish family, we need them and they need us.

Can any family today live up to the title "holy"? We may think the world today is more difficult and challenging than in the time of Jesus, but for their time, their challenges were just as difficult to them as ours are to us. The best we can do is trust in God and follow his will. In 1979, Sister Sledge released the song We Are Family that contains the line, "Have faith in you and the things you do." You can have faith in the things you do IF you have faith in God. In that way, we will become one holy family.

PARISH ENVELOPES FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY



You should be receiving your monthly envelope packets for January.

If you haven't received the new envelopes and would like to, or if you have received the envelopes but do not wish to, please contact the parish office so we can address the issue. Our aim is to help you understand the purpose of each envelope as we progress together as one parish.

January Envelopes will include:

1. Sunday Collection Envelopes

These envelopes contribute to the operational costs of both church campuses.

2. Monthly Donation Blessings Envelope

To help minimize envelope costs, this envelope will feature multiple giving options. Please make sure you mark the checkboxes to indicate where you wish your donation to go:

a. Early Childhood Learning Center - These funds support the administrative costs associated with our ECLCs, as well as the housing and utility expenses for both St. Luke and St. Charles ECLC facilities.

b. Security - Contributions to this fund help cover security expenses during all weekend Masses as well help offset the cost for the expenses for other security systems, such as cameras.

c. Capital Fund - Donations to this fund enable the parish to maintain and finance improvements for both church grounds.

3. Catholic Echo Magazine Envelope

This envelope is distributed annually to assist in covering the monthly subscription cost for each parishioner to receive the Catholic Echo. We kindly ask for a contribution to help offset this expense.

4. Initial Offering Envelope

This envelope is distributed annually, and the funds collected assist in covering the yearly printing costs.

5. Church Overseas Envelope

This combined collection supports four major overseas services: Catholic Relief Services (CRS), Holy Father/Peter's Pence, the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, and the Church in Latin America.

6. Mens Club/Holy Name Society Envelope

This annual envelope is designed for individuals associated with these specific ministries, allowing them to conveniently pay their yearly dues.

7. Educational Endowment Fund Envelope

This envelope will be distributed every quarter, and the funds collected will be deposited into a designated bank account to assist in covering tuition costs for St. Charles School.


